It's time to submit candidates for 2014 elected and selected positions. Among the open elected positions are ACR president and vice president; six positions on the Board of Chancellors, three of which are held by incumbents eligible to run for a second term; four positions on the Council Steering Committee; three positions on the College Nominating Committee (CNC); and two member-in-training representatives to the Intersociety Conference (ISC). Additionally, the CNC will select a private-practice representative to the 2014 and 2015 ISC meetings.

Any ACR member may submit recommendations to the CNC for elected or selected positions in care of the ACR Governance Office on or before Dec. 31, 2013. You may also complete the Candidate Information Form online and submit via email to Kathy Bentley at KBentley@acr.org or to ACR headquarters at 1891 Preston White Drive, Reston, VA 20191, by Dec. 31, 2013. 
