Chapter Success — Chapter Rejuvenation of the Hawaii Radiological Society (HRS)

In 2011, HRS officers approached the process of chapter rejuvenation. Dr. Peter H. Takeyama, president of the chapter, notes that the first step was surveying members and former members about the inactivity of the chapter. While there was not one particular cause identified, Dr. Takeyama noted a challenge faced by many smaller chapters: lacking critical mass and sufficient member involvement to maintain a thriving chapter. Through conversations with their colleagues, the officers learned a priority for members was offering more options for members to earn CME without having to travel considerable distances to get CME on the mainland. To attract individuals to attend their first meeting and potentially join the chapter, they offered a CME event. In order to be responsive to a preference for meetings with an educational component, the chapter collaborated with Tripler Army Medical Center, the only residency program in Hawaii, to share the costs for guest speakers to lecture at CME events. Officers plan to continue offering CME meetings in 2012. At their first business meeting, new officers were elected; revised bylaws were adopted during the next meeting and a schedule for future meetings was determined.

The officers found a general misunderstanding of the merits of ACR membership versus other organizations such as RSNA. The importance of the ACR is now clearer to members as they are faced with challenges like the MPPR, reimbursement cuts and the loss of hospital contracts. The HRS sent a delegation to the 2012 AMCLC and participated in Capitol Hill Day. Chapter leaders are investigating more ways to get involved in government relations activities and continue to share information on College advocacy with their members. By assessing the needs of radiologists in their state and returning the chapter to an active status, the HRS is moving in the right direction to grow their membership and increase their involvement in ACR activities.
